## Care of Industrial Objects

Specialized Course with CCI

*Care of Industrial Objects* focuses on the care of locomotives, airplanes, road vehicles, and agricultural machinery, with special emphasis on outdoor environments. Key components in preserving these objects include determining the causes of deterioration, assessing the display and storage sites, and implementing appropriate remedial measures and maintenance. Special emphasis is placed on documentation and research. Participants will have the opportunity to share their expertise and experience, and to ask questions on specific projects and problems. Objects in the collection of the host museum will be examined in detail.

Upon completion of *Care of Industrial Objects* participants will be able to:

- accurately document the condition of an industrial object with digital photographs, written text, and related graphics
- analyze and prioritize the problems associated with the objects in various outdoor environments
- devise practical solutions to problems
- organize and present a report that is both practical and persuasive

**Who should attend:** Staff and volunteers of museums and interpretive sites with industrial objects on display or in storage, both indoors and outside.

**Date, Location & Time:** June 23 & 24, Manitoba Agricultural Museum (Austin), 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM daily

**Instructor:** George Prytulak

**Special notes:** *Participants are encouraged to bring their own laptops and digital cameras.*

**Fee:** \$125 for AMM members, \$165 for non-members. Fees include all course materials and lunch. AMM institutional members in good standing may send two individuals to the course at member rates.
