Deaccessioning Specialized Course

Are your storage areas full from 30 years of collecting? Do you have too many widgets but you'd really like to find a whimsy? Has the mandate of your museum evolved or been refined over the years? If so, **Deaccessioning** is the course for you. The course is designed to complement the *Collections Management* course, although this is not a prerequisite. (*Collections Management* will be offered the day before this course at the same location and time of day.) *Please note that Deaccessioning is a Specialized course and not part of the Certificate Program in Museum Practice.*

Who should attend: The course is designed for those who work with, or have responsibility for, a museum collection, including board members, staff and volunteers

Course Content:

- preventive deaccessioning
- policy development
- assessment of artifacts
- procedures for handling individual artifacts and larger projects
- discussion of ethics

Date, Location and Time: April 24th, Minnedosa 50+ Seniors Activity Centre, 31 Main Street South in Minnedosa, from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM

Instructor: Nancy Anderson, The Manitoba Museum
