Deaccessioning Specialized Course

Are your storage areas full from 30 years of collecting? Do you have too many widgets but you'd really like to find a whimsy? Has the mandate of your museum evolved or been refined over the years? If so, **Deaccessioning** is the course for you. The course is designed to complement the Collections Management course, although this is not a prerequisite. (The Collections Management will be offered the day before this course at the same location and time.)

Who should attend: The course is designed for those who work with, or have responsibility for, a museum collection, including board members, staff and volunteers

Course Content:

- preventive deaccessioning
- policy development
- assessment of artifacts
- procedures for handling individual artifacts and larger projects
- discussion of ethics

Fee: \$75 for AMM members; \$110 for non-members. Fees include all course materials and lunch. AMM institutional members in good standing may send two individuals to the course at member rates.

Registration deadline: One week prior to the course date.

Travel Assistance: Travel grants of up to \$400 are available, for qualified applicants, from the Canadian Museums Association Bursary Program. Applications are to be made through the AMM office. Applications must be made at least 3 weeks in advance of the event.
