

The Cultural Stewardship Program (CSP) provides preventive conservation and collections care services to help you preserve your artifacts. From storage and packing to facilities and buildings, from exhibits and pests to emergency response and disaster planning, the CSP conservator is available to assist you with your conservation issues.

If you would like to work on *Preventive Conservation* or *Emergency Preparedness*, we can help. Would you like a site visit? An artifact condition assessment? An information session for your board? A meeting to discuss your conservation concerns? Let us know and we will discuss a plan to address your needs.

In-person site visits will be carried out via Zoom or other video-conferencing program, or in-person with COVID-19 protocols in effect, and in accordance with the latest updates for the five health regions. Contact is between the CSP conservator and only one representative of the institution, without exceeding the permitted visitor capacity. Masking and social distancing are required. The CSP conservator will sanitize her hands before entering a building and wear gloves throughout the visit. A brief questionnaire to confirm the health of the site's staff and volunteers is sent out prior to the visit. If there are any concerns, the site visit will be postponed. Contact information is provided for the CSP conservator and is requested for all people connected to the site.

Site Visits

A *basic* site visit can help address a particular problem or evaluate factors that may be affecting the preservation of your collection. An *in-depth* side visit includes environmental monitoring and pest monitoring, with the results included in the final report. A basic site visit can only be carried out via Zoom or other video-conferencing program.

Site Visit fees will be waived for Members in 2021, to help reduce the impact of COVID-19 on museums.

Training

Environmental Monitoring

Protecting your collection from dampness and overheating is easier if you know what the environmental conditions actually are. The CSP can loan you monitoring equipment or help you do it yourself, so you can improve storage and exhibit areas.

Insects and rodents love museums! The CSP can help you prevent, identify and deal with unwelcome visitors using a common-sense approach based on Integrated Pest Management. Traps can be provided free of charge, and Information on trapping and identification can be found in the AMM Pest Guide.
