Learning Opportunities

The AMM offers excellent learning opportunities for staff (paid and volunteer) and board members including:

- Annual Conference
- Certificate Program in Museum Practice (CPMP) consists of eight, one- or two-day in-person courses or 4 – 6 online sessions (in development) designed to give a basic understanding of museum work and its unique needs for those who are new to the museum world or who wish to obtain a better understanding of museums. The courses include:
 - *Organizing and Managing Museums*
 - *Museums and the Community*
 - *Collections Management*
 - *Collections Care and Preventive Conservation*
 - *Research: Policies, plans...action!*
 - *Exhibit Design*
 - *Museums and Education*
 - *The Museum Facility*
- Specialized Courses, designed to augment the CPMP or provide information in a specialized area

Cultural Stewardship Program

The Cultural Stewardship Program (CSP) helps museums look after their artifacts. From storage and packing to facilities and buildings, the CSP helps members with their conservation issues. CSP services available to AMM members for a nominal fee include:

- Site visits
- Advisory services on preventive conservation and emergency preparedness
- Loan and interpretation of Environmental Monitoring Equipment and Pest Monitoring Kits

All CSP fees will be waived for Members until further notice to help reduce the impact of COVID-19 on museums.
