## **Database Update**

This pilot project was initiated by 2 of 5 partner museums. The 5 being: The Manitoba Sports Hall of Fame & Museum, Dalnavert Museum, Ogniwo Polish Museum, Transcona Museum, and the Manitoba Crafts Museum & Library.

The AMM is working with these museums to customize collections management database software for museums in Manitoba.
